



## **Fundraising Activities - UK**

Our fundraising activities in the UK involve sponsorship programmes for both the Right to Dream Academy and the Right to Dream Underprivileged Children's Centre (UCC), individual fundraising efforts and making applications to grant making organisations. ### **Sponsor the Right to Dream Academy**

Why not become responsible for transforming a child's life by sponsoring a scholarship at the new Academy. This opportunity would afford you the opportunity, if you choose, to build a life-long relationship with the scholar who would be excited to know that someone is personally interested in their progress whilst they are at the Academy and as they graduate and start to build a life for themselves. Your contribution would cover the costs of the child's education, training, accommodation, diet and personal development programme.

Your sponsorship will give you the opportunity, if you wish, to establish direct contact with one of our pupils. Those pupils who currently have sponsors take great pride in the fact they have a friend in the UK/US/Ghana who are personally concerned with their development and future. They all keep in regular contact, as your sponsored pupil will through email.

The annual costs of each scholarship are £5,000, you could sponsor the whole or part costs of a scholarship – any donation, no matter how small or large is valued by our Academy.

### ***Sponsor the Underprivileged Children's Centre (UCC)***

If you would like to support the Right to Dream UCC, our drop in education and welfare centre for children from a background of extreme poverty, then you can sponsor a child, which will enable that child to attend school and have all the support necessary for them to thrive. £10 a month can provide a child with food, shelter, education and pastoral care.

You will have the opportunity, if you choose, to have regular e-mail contact with the child you sponsor. Like the Academy pupils, the children attending the UCC will take great pride in the fact they have a friend in another country personally concerned with their development and future.

If you are interested, you could also make a one-off or monthly donation to cover the cost of the teaching resources and running costs.

### ***Sponsor the Academy Education Programme***

*'The foundation of every state is the education of its youth'* (Diogenes Laertius) and with the construction of the new Academy comes the opportunity to take the international school to a whole new level in the Academy's development which will benefit all pupils. Why not demonstrate your support for our activities by sponsoring the new education programme, which will comprise of remedial, international (ICE Checkpoint and IGCSE) and vocational elements. The new programme will also take into account the huge range of abilities of the Academy pupils, the result of their diverse academic backgrounds and will give every child the appropriate skills required for the opportunities they will pursue upon graduation.

Right to Dream works with some of the most underprivileged children in West Africa, few if any arrive at the Academy owning many of their own personal belongings, indeed most arrive with simply the clothes they are wearing. The UCC also works with some of the most deprived children in Ghana, who cannot afford to attend school.
